A Special Budget Meeting of the Common Council of the City of Salem was called to order by Council President Karen Roots. The meeting took place in the Municipal Annex located at 17 New Market Street at 9:00 a.m. The meeting was opened with the Pledge of Allegiance. Present: Council President Karen Roots, Councilpersons, Ruth Carter, Charles Hassler, Horace Johnson, and Lydia Thompson. Councilmen Earl Gage and Vaughn Groce joined the meeting via conference call. Council President announced that a quorum was present. Also in attendance were CFO David Crescenzi and City Clerk Kathleen L. Keen.

INTRODUCTION OF RESOLUTIONS FOR CONSIDERATION

RESOLUTION 2016-73 A RESOLUTION TO AVERAGE THE TAX COLLECTION RATE FOR USE IN THE 2016 MUNICIPAL BUDGET

WHEREAS, the City of Salem experienced a decline in the tax collection rate for the year 2015;

WHEREAS, the use of the lower collection rate in arriving at the budget appropriation Reserve for Uncollected Taxes in the 2016 Municipal Budget would result in an unfair tax burden to the taxpayers of the City of Salem; and

WHEREAS, the Division of Local Government Services, Department of Community Affairs will allow the City of Salem to use the average of the prior three years' collection rates in calculating the budget appropriation Reserve for Uncollected Taxes in the 2016 Municipal Budget; and

WHEREAS, the prior three years' collection rates are 88.13% for 2014, 87.35% for 2013 and 86.05% for 2012; and

WHEREAS, the averaging of the prior three years' collection rates result in a collection rate of 87.18%;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City of Salem will use the collection rate of 85.00% in calculating the budget appropriation Reserve for Uncollected Taxes in the 2016 Municipal Budget.

CFO Crescenzi explained the collection rate of 85.00% was determined during a discussion with the State Finance Board and the City Auditor.
